





Trivia Answer

On Feb. 26, 1911, a small band of Shoshone men, women and children were cornered in a shoot-out north of Winnemucca. The group, later called the last free Indians in the country, had allegedly killed four stockmen in January. State police and a sheriff's posse killed the men and arrested the others, who were later sent to out of state reservations.
