
What a wonderful year of growth and accomplishment in our Carson City Republican

COMMANDER GLENN TIERNEY



Glenn Tierney was born in the New York area of New Jersey in 1924.

When his dad took him aboard the Navy's first Aircraft Carrier, 10 year old Glenn declared he was going to be a Navy pilot and he did, getting his wings and commission in 1944 at age 20.

Glenn flew over 40 different aircraft in a career spanning WWII, Korea and Vietnam.

But his career highlight was serving as the Chief Test Pilot for the

SIDEWINDER guided missile!

Flying an Air Force F-104, he fired Sidewinders at over twice the speed of sound and well above 50,000 feet, giving American Airmen a weapon that has destroyed numerous enemy aircraft and will remain in use until at least 2055.

A statue of Glenn will soon be displayed at the Naval Test Facility at China Lake near Ridgecrest California.

Completing his 30 year Naval career, Commander Tierney retired to Lake Tahoe in 1972 and opened a real estate appraisal business.

Glen and his wife, Cathy, later retired to Southern California, where he served as a docent on the U.S.S. Midway in SanDiego. They now reside in Carson City.

INCREASE OF MEMBERSHIP DUES

As required by the NFRW all NvFRW clubs send a portion (formerly \$15)of our membership dues to our State Treasurer with the following rates in effect - \$5 per member per year stayed with the NvFRW and \$10 per member per year was sent to the NFRW; however, due to recent actions by NFRW, the portion of our dues sent to NFRW is now \$20 per member per year. The portion the NvFRW keeps will remain at \$5, meaning \$25 of our current \$30 membership dues goes to NvFRW and NFRW. Following discussion at the November CCRW BOD meeting, the following changes in membership rates were adopted:

- For renewing members, dues will remain at \$30 through December 31, 2019. Beginning January 1, 2020 dues for renewing members will be \$40. Be smart—pay now!!
 - For new members dues are now \$40. For Associate members dues are now \$20.

Due to increases in printing related costs, the cost for those wishing a USPS mailed copy of the newsletter is now \$20.




