

RED Jewel, do you have yours?



#### SUPERVISOR REPORT Lori Bagwell, Ward 3

I listened to a report from Kim Donohue from the Nevada Department of Veterans Services (NDVS) that I think you might be interested in some information. NDVS is tasked with assisting Nevada Veterans and their families. NDVS must first identify them. The department does not currently have a comprehensive way to maintain an accurate list of veterans within the state.

To help veterans receive all the benefits and services they are entitled to, NDVS is beginning a process of digitizing 88,000 DD-214's (military records) into an electronic format. It is estimated the project will take one year to complete. NDVS is asking for volunteers from the Carson City area (the records are at the State Library) to help scan the documents.

The States of Utah and Alaska funded the programming of the records, thereby making it possible for Nevada to participate at such a low cost. I thought maybe a few of you would like to volunteer to help with this worthy program. I know you feel as I do—our veterans matter—and this is a way for us to help them.
