HAPPY NEW YEAR EVERYONE!

Caring For America has four "causes" that it supports: Advocates To End Domestic Violence, CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate), The Northern Nevada Dream Center and Paws Up For Veterans. CCRW supported them in 2018 and will again in 2019.

2018 was a year of "giving". The following will tell you what we did together as a group of generous and compassionate Republican women.

The Northern Nevada Dream Center is right here in Carson City at 3579 Hwy. 50 E, #211. They provide meals, dry food items, clothing and more to the needy. Trips were made to them with "gently used" clothing, donated by our members. We donated \$822.00 to them to use as needed. THANK YOU!

Paws Up For Veterans, A Fallon based organization, trains dogs to become Service Dogs. Ann and husband Bob acquire the dogs, train them and give them for free to a Veteran in need of a Service Dog. You donated, in 2018, a total of \$978.00 to help them do what they do for our Veterans. THANK YOU!

CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) helps children who are victims of neglect or abuse here in Carson City. In 2018, CCRW donated 22 suitcases/duffel bags or bigger backpacks, each with a soft throw and a cuddly creature inside. We have \$60.00 left to buy more suitcases and 25 cuddly creatures waiting to be given away. There is a need for throws. You also donated eight blankets and some pairs of white crew socks to CASA. THANK YOU!

Advocates To End Domestic Violence gives us a "Special Wish List" at Christmas for items for the women and children at the shelter. This year there were 10 Moms and 21 children. Your CCRW Board and other members bought all of the items on the list! CCRW gave 31 NEW gifts from the list, plus 19 additional gifts. We also received \$50.00 in cash donated to Advocates. Nancy Dallas and her "Giving Friends" gave an additional 34 NEW items. Grand total of NEW gifts for Advocates was 84! THANK YOU ALL!! Your generosity and caring is deeply appreciated and admired. THANK YOU!

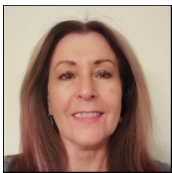
