The libraries appreciate our contributions and hopefully readers will enjoy the opportunity to read about history and current events.



#### SHERI LETOURNEAU, 1<sup>ST</sup> VP, LEGISLATIVE CHAIR

As of writing this article, April 24, 2019, there are only (LOL) forty days remaining until Adjournment Sine Die, Some dates to watch for, according to the Legislative Calendar, are:

- Economic Forum Report Due Mav 1
- May 3 Start Resolving Budget Differences
- May 17 Committee Passage (Second House)
- May 23 May 24 Finish Budget Differences
- Second House Passage
- May 29 Budget Bills Introduced / Exempt Bills from Committee
- June 3 Sine Die

#### Status on a few of the Bills we continue to monitor:

#### AB 281 Makes Nevada a Sanctuary State

- April 11 From Committee: Do pass
- April 15 Read second time
- April 16 Taken from General File. Placed on Chief Clerk's desk
- April 24 Pursuant to Joint Standing Rule, no further action allowed

#### AB 186 National Popular Vote (does away with the Electoral College)

- April 11 From Committee: Amend and do pass as amended
- April 15 Read second time: Amended
- April 16 Read third time: passed as amended (Yeas 23, Nays 17, Excused 2). To Sen-
- April 17 In Senate: referred to Committee on Legislative Operations and Elections

#### SB 123 Same Day Voter Registration and Voting on Election Day

- March 18 Notice of eligibility for exemption
- April 22 Amend and do pass as amended. Re-referred to Committee on Finance
- April 23 Exemption effective

#### SB 179 Revises Provisions Relating to Abortions

- April 15 From Committee: Amend and do pass as amended
- April 16 Passed as amended (Yeas 12, Nays 9). To Assembly
- April 17 In Assembly: Referred to Committee on Health and Human Services
