CCRW JUNE GENERAL MEETING

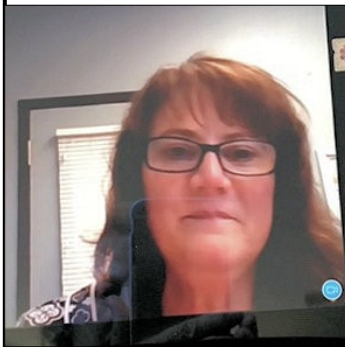
VIA ZOOM

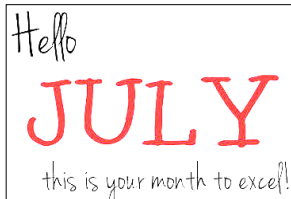


CCRW Satellite Meetings
