NOTES FROM THE EDITOR

The Continuing Saga of The Elephant Logo's Stars



We received a response to the question I mentioned in the last issue of this newsletter. WHO, WHEN, AND WHY were the stars on the GOP elephant turned upside-down? It piqued the curiosity of one of our readers, who sent me this informative email with links to some answers.

I could not resist looking up your question about why the stars on the elephant logo are upside down. Check these out. "Why were the stars turned upside down in the Republican Elephant in 2000? This Bing video explains the star concern.

Also, see Political Pistachio: Study of the GOP's Upside Down Stars nicely explains that it was NOT Bush and offers a couple of ideas. Please do a follow-up article once you find the answer! Warm regards, Kathryn E Kelly, DrPH, MEd, Executive Director I-School

Thanks, Kathryn; this research disproves some of the below-noted myths surrounding the change. "A Few of the Theories

- The GOP made a deal with the devil, and the inverted stars represent a pentagram!
- When a country is in distress, its flag is flown upside down—thus the change in the stars' direction
- Some college intern graphic designers did it for fun to see if anyone would notice.

As a result of the research Kathryn found, we can rule out that the change came in 2000. Several campaign logos and election buttons well before the emergence of Bush Jr. show the stars upside-down. See examples on the website: Political Pistachio: Study of the GOP's Upside Down Stars (above).

Further, the change of the direction of the stars neither happened randomly or covertly. According to U.S. Trademark Applications and Registrations Retrieval database, it was issued Trademark No. 1908397, filed in 1993, and registered in 1995. The first use date is 1969, and it appears on the '72 Republican Convention rule booklet, complete with upside-down logo stars. Thus debunking the unnoticed graphic error theory.

However, it still leaves the question, **who** decided on the reversal when the trademark was applied for and **why** it was done? Still wondering...

Let's help our teachers! Let's take back our schools!

Nearly two centuries ago, visionaries such as Horace Mann and John Dewey brought forward the concept of government providing a public school system paid for by tax dollars. The goal was for every American child to get a basic education in reading, writing, math, science, and history to become a productive member of society.

Unfortunately, America has pushed out much of our core education and replaced it with content intended to indoctrinate our children. The powers that be understand that what we teach our children is vital to define what kind of country we are. As the direction of our nation becomes more of a political struggle, those who have charge over our schools seek to create a nation that reflects their goals and values. Parents are kept at bay while the teachers' unions, university education departments, and the state legislatures and bureaucracies fill our children's heads with social justice, racial justice (BLM), environmental justice, and way-too-young sexualization of their bodies. We must push back on this.

It is true. *As goes our children, so goes our nation.* A secondary but also distressing result of the piling on of all these politically-charged materials is the amount of pressure it heaps on teachers. Even if they want to meet the educational needs of their students, there simply isn't enough time to educate them in the basic core subjects. How schools are currently handling discipline, which is also part of the political maneuvering, is a huge hurdle. The issue of being able to control the students in the classroom has reached a crisis level. The far left's insistence through the Nevada Legislature on Restorative Justice (or Restorative Practices as it is called in the policy our school district adopted) has taken the sting out of consequences for actions.

Ironically, research shows that school administrators and other staff have fared far better in getting higher salaries than those we charge with educating our kids.

I believe that teachers deserve more respect and support – and pay. If our superintendent is to be paid \$166,000 a year plus benefits, then I think that teachers, being on the front lines, should be supported much more.

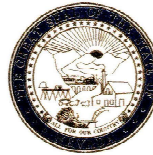
