1st VP/Programs Message

VOTE NO on These Dangerous Ballot Questions!

Our Ballot Questions have been released for this election cycle and are dangerous. As people who love Nevada, you should Vote 'NO' to these three changes to Nevada's Constitution.



Question Number 1, titled ERA, is an attack on women. We are all guaranteed equal rights at this time, but this strips away Women's rights. If this initiative passes, it will be an amendment to our Constitution.

Here is part of the language for the proposed amendment: "Equality of rights under the law shall not be denied or abridged by this State or any of its political subdivisions on account of race, color, creed, SEX, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY OR EXPRESSION, AGE, disability ancestry or national origin." Trans Genders will be allowed in girls' showers, play girls' sports, etc. See related flyer at CarsonCityRepublicans.com website to learn what this means to our daughters and granddaughters. We must vote 'NO' on Question 1.

Question 2 Relates to a Minimum Wage increase. We do not need the government to regulate wages as the economy naturally dictates the rate for a job by competition. Employers with this wage increase forced on them will either lay people off or pass these costs onto the consumer. As an example, McDonald's is moving towards automated food serving instead of having a live person assisting customers thus needing fewer employees. Therefore, as Republicans, we should Vote 'NO' on 2.

Question 3 will ensure Nevadans become an eastern part of California, so we must vote 'NO' on this initiative. Understand, this is California's Voting System. Question 3 reads: Shall the Nevada Constitution be amended to allow all Nevada voters the right to participate in open primary elections to choose candidates for the general election in which all voters may then rank the remaining candidates by a

preference for the offices of U.S. Senators, U.S. Representatives, Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, State Controller, Attorney General, and State Legislators? Several states have tried this system, and it did not work. California uses rank voting, and we all see what has happened to that failed state. Therefore, we must all vote 'NO' on Question 3.

Please share with every potential voter you know. The definitions of Questions are intentionally misleading to make voters believe it's good for



In October 2021, GOP Reps. Andrew Garbarino and Mark Amodei led the effort on a resolution supporting Columbus Day. They stated they believe the federal holiday should continue to commemorate the Italian explorer for his role in discovering America amid the left-wing push to make it Indigenous Peoples' Day.

The resolution comes as numerous cities have opted not to recognize Columbus Day, arguing it should be replaced by Indigenous Peoples' Day, citing European explorers' abuse of Native Americans upon their arrival on the continent.

However, proponents of the holiday feel it is important to preserve the history behind Columbus' role in founding the land, which is a significant part of Italian-American history. Nevada continues to observe Columbus Day with banks and schools being closed.

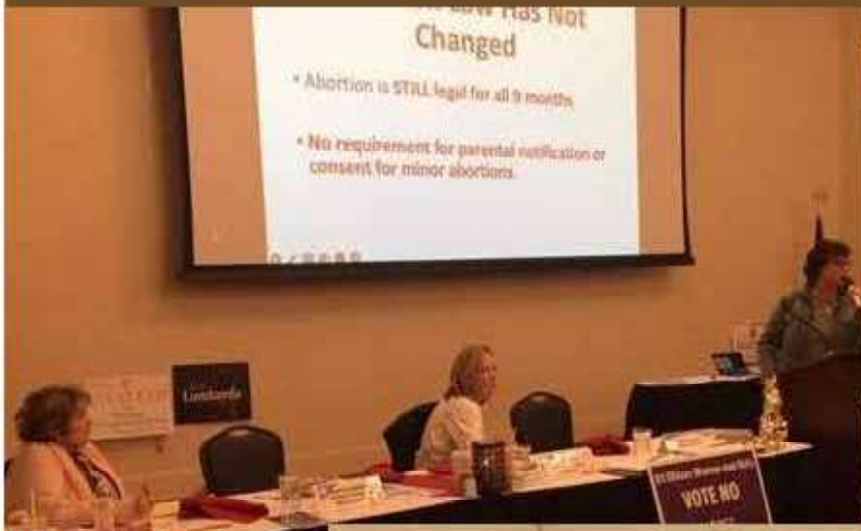

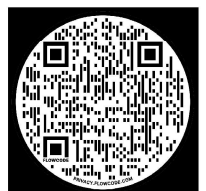
