Misinformation is being spread, but the correct data is that ***you may*** vote in the Presidential Preference Primary on February 6 and the Republican Caucus on February 8. There will be NO same-day voter registration; please check to confirm that you are registered to the party of your choice. Understanding that only the candidates participating in the Caucus will secure delegates for the Republican National Convention is essential. Candidates in the Presidential Preference Primary will not receive delegates for the National Convention.

Our office will also make informational phone calls to you; we want you to be comfortable with the process and answer any questions. Please call (775) 841-1800 if you have questions.

These are the Candidates participating in the State-Run Presidential Primary on February 6:

John Castro, Heath Fulkerson, Nikki Haley, Donald Kjornes, and Hirsh V. Singh. Once more, these candidates do not receive any delegates for the National Republican Convention.

These are the Candidates participating in the Republican Caucus: Ryan Binkley, Doug Burgum, Chris Chirsty, Ron DeSantis, Vivek Ramaswamy, and Donal. We are a Caucus State and have been

Caucusing historically for years. We caucused in 2008, 2012, and 2016. We did not Caucus in 2020 because we had an Incumbent President. Remember, in 2021, we were in lockdown with COVID-19, and the legislature was closed to the people. Sisolack and the Democratic Legislature passed AB321 late at night, giving us the horrid election laws we must live with. This law gave us No Voter ID, Universal mail-in Ballots, and legal ballot harvesting.

The Democratic Legislature also passed AB126 last year, with every Republican Assemblymember and Senator voting against the bill. This bill dictated that the Republican Party would select their delegates through a Presidential Primary instead of a Caucus. Once more, the Republican Party of Nevada historically selects its Presidential Candidate through a Caucus. The Nevada Republican Party has decided that we will choose our Presidential

We will use Voter ID, Paper Ballots, no Electronic Voting Equipment, transparency, and a quick determination of who won delegates. Is this not what Republicans want? It is a win-win for our party. Plan on Caucusing on February 8. Your vote will count.

## Tax-smart ways to donate stock to your favorite nonprofit

Did your stocks appreciate considerably in the past couple of years and you are wondering how to minimize capital gains taxes? In this season of Giving Tuesday and year-end charitable donations, an often overlooked win-win option is to donate stock, real estate or other non-cash assets you have held for at least a year to a nonprofit cause you care about and get some tax benefits.

Why not just write a check instead? Because by the time you sell the stock and pay capital gains taxes, you may lose up to a third of the original value. That excess value goes to the IRS and not to the nonprofit.

But not that many know about donating stock. According to a recent study by Fidelity Charitable, only half of respondents knew you could even donate stock, and fewer than one in five have actually done so.

Here are the simple steps to donate stock to a nonprofit:

1. Contact the nonprofit to which you would like to donate. Confirm they have a brokerage account and can accept stock donations. Not all nonprofits can or do.
2. If yes, ask for their depository trust company (DTC) information and clearing number for their brokerage account. This will allow you to transfer the stock electronically from your brokerage account to theirs. (If the nonprofit does not have a brokerage account, they can use a third-party provider such as donatestock.com who will help make the transfer for a 3% fee.) The information your broker will typically need is the name, mailing address, and DTC number of the brokerage where the nonprofit has an account as well as the nonprofit's legal name, tax ID number and brokerage account number.
3. Choose a low transaction fee provider such as Schwab to set up a brokerage account if you don't already have one.
4. Fill out your broker's stock donation form.
5. Your broker will transfer the stock to the nonprofit's brokerage account.

The transfer may take a few days to complete, so make sure you initiate it before the end of the year if you want to claim the tax deduction for that year. Some brokerages have much earlier deadlines to process end-of-the-year DTC transfers, like Dec. 15.

Here's the benefit: By donating stock to a nonprofit, you can avoid paying capital gains taxes on the appreciation of the stock and increase your gift and your tax deduction by up to 20%. You also can make a bigger impact on the causes you care about and help them achieve their goals. For example, your donation could help fund a new building for one of the growing numbers of independent microschools, provide teacher training, or fund scholarships for deserving students, or any other important causes: the arts, animal welfare, emergency relief and more.

That's it! The nonprofit may retain the stock in the hope it will continue to appreciate, or it may convert it to cash for immediate needs.

You will receive a receipt for your donation, which you can use to claim a tax deduction for the full fair market value of the stock at the time of the transfer.

Of course, your circumstances may vary, so be sure to check with a financial adviser first.

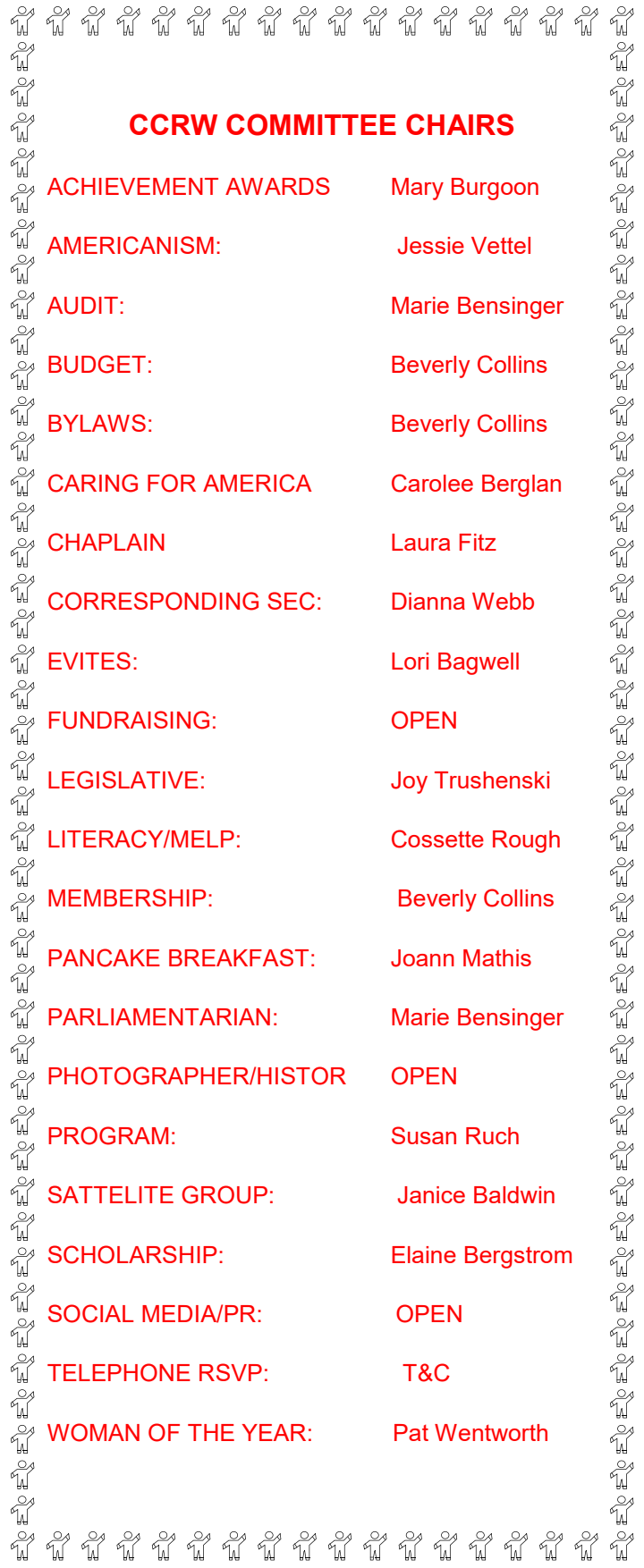

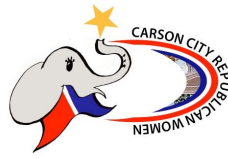

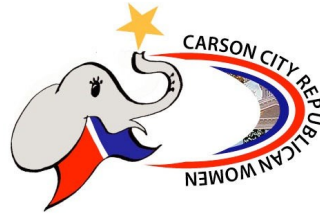
