KIMBERLY ADAMS ASSESSSOR CARSON CITY ASSESSORS OFFICE

Kimberly Adams, Assessor, of the Carson City Assessor's Office will be sharing with the CCRW luncheon attendees. Kimberly will explain the duties of the Assessor's office and explain how property is valued for tax purposes The Assessor values all property subject to taxation. The Assessor is required by Nevada law to discover, list and value all property within the county. The property is assessed at 35% of its current appraised value. In addition to over 20,000 parcels of real property (land, homes, commercial buildings), the Assessor must value personal property of approximately 3,500 businesses from casinos to one person operations, over 3,000 mobile homes, 200 aircraft, and any other personal property which is taxable. The personal property taxes are collected by the Carson City Treasurers office.

Currently after the primaries Donald Trump is leading with 32 delegates, Nikki Haley with 17 delegates, Ron DeSantis (dropped out 1/21) 9 delegates and Vivek Ramaswamy (dropped out 1/15) 3 delegates. It takes 1215 delegates at the convention, in Milwaukee, WI on July 15– 18, 2024 to be declared the nominee

It is important that we all make sure we attend the caucus on February 8, 2024 . Starting at 5:30 p.m., precinct meetings will be called to order at each caucus location. This includes additional activities:

- Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.
- Election of precinct caucus chair and secretary.

- Consideration of 2024 GOP platform planks. Opportunity to speak in favor of a candidate.

No sooner than 7:30 p.m. and not before all precinct business is completed, votes will be counted. As Republicans we should keep ourselves informed about these primaries because not always does the Super Tuesday winner become the nominee. The states conducting elections on 2024's Super Tuesday on March 5, 2024 include Alabama, Arkansas, Alaska, California, Colorado, Iowa, Maine, Massachusetts, Minnesota, North Carolina, Oklahoma, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Vermont and Virginia.






